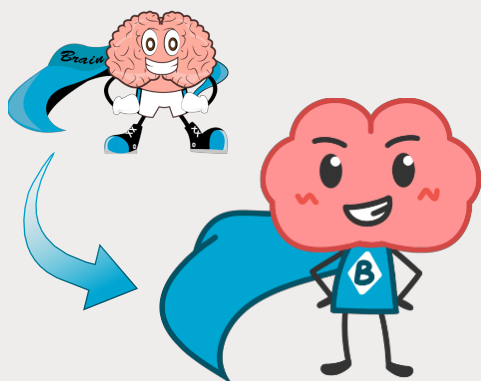


## Welcome to the BrainReach North Newsletter!
